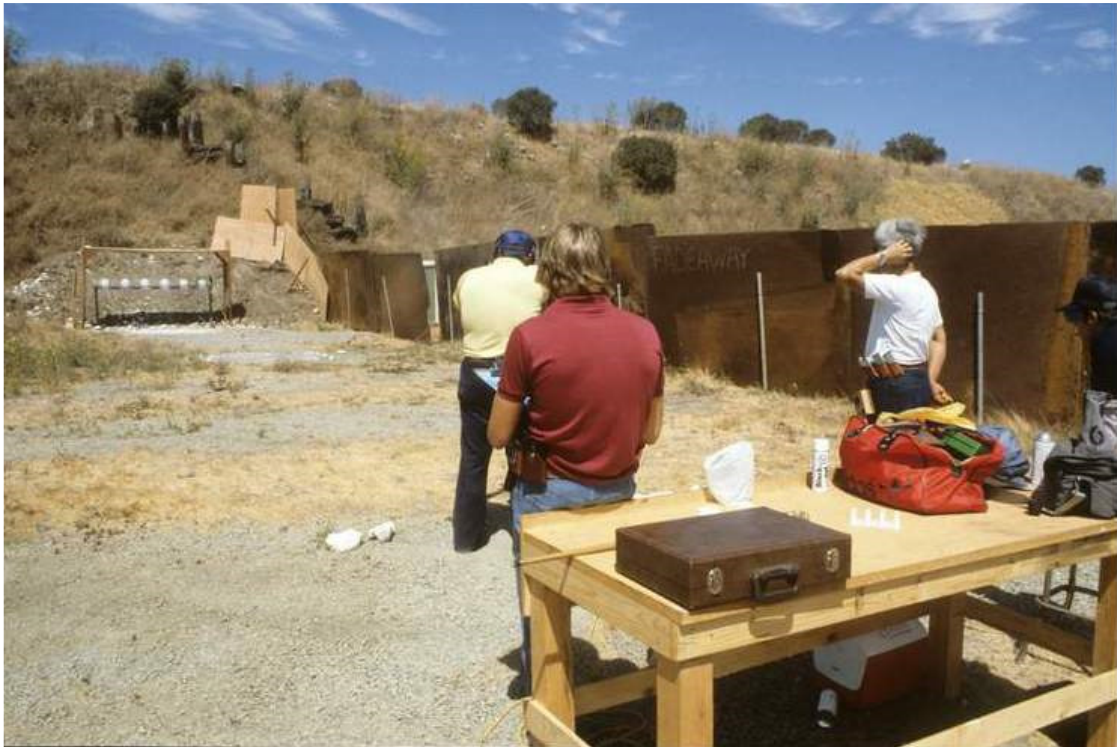

If your name is on the list above, you need not call and ask me when your membership card is coming, it will be put into the mail around the middle of the month, in which this notice has been sent (If January, around Jan 15th, if March, around March 15th, and so on).

Any member, that did not renew by September 15th 2013, has now been dropped. Any member that has let their membership lapse and has a gate card will now have said gate card disabled.
