PRESIDENT'S CORNER



Greetings,

I would like to discuss two important matters this month. The first is the issue of volunteerism. The Club could not function without all of the volunteer work performed by our members. If you are one of these folks, there is no need to say anymore other than thank you very much. If you haven't gotten involved in helping out, you should consider doing so. We have a few projects we're working on, which can save the club a bundle of money. Some projects have to be done by outside contractors and that is the nature of our business, however many projects can be completed by members.

We have approximately 1,800 members from all professions and a wealth of talent. In the coming months, we will be doing some renovations to the bar and kitchen, which I know can be accomplished by volunteer members pitching in and putting in a few hours of their time. When asked, please step up and contribute to the effort for everyone's sake.

One of the reasons I am making this request at this time is due to current political issues facing us. The City of Richmond is updating its general plan, and one of the last issues is the zoning of the North shore area, which includes our property. There are plans to downzone the area to Open Space, which would devalue the surrounding properties, prevent any development, and leave us as the last remaining “obstacle” in the way of the “green” or nothing folks. Needless to say, the legal battle that will ensue will be very costly for both the City and us. We have been at this location for over a half century, and to try to force us out is both unnecessary and unwarranted. With the withdrawal of redevelopment monies, the city cannot afford to further reduce its income from existing businesses and deny property owners the right to develop their property in a thoughtful, productive manner. The powers to be should reach a decision which permits us to continue conducting our business, serving the public and 30+ law enforcement agencies, while permitting our neighbors to develop their property. Get involved in the Club and local politics that affect our right to co-exist.
