PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Greetings Members:

I would like to dedicate this message to all members, new and old. As some of you may know, we only have two employees on the payroll, the bartender and the caretaker. Everyone else volunteers to run the ranges; the clubhouse, dinners & breakfasts; administration including the Board of Directors; grounds and maintenance; and everything else that is necessary to keep the Club operational. We currently have over 2,000 members to draw from to get the volunteers required to keep our doors open to serve our members and the public.

You may think it would be simple to recruit enough members to fill all of the positions required to staff the necessary slots required to run a safe and efficient shooting facility. However, at this time all of the standing committees are staffed and operational by virtue of the BOD and other volunteers. The action range has 65 or more volunteer RO's and other volunteers that are able to run that range efficiently. A long time shortage of volunteer RO's at the Rifle and Pistol Range is slowly being staffed at an acceptable level, but can always use more help. The Trap & Skeet Range has a serious shortage of RO's and needs folks to step up and fill in, in order to keep proper staffing levels to insure safe and efficient operations.

The primary duties of a Range Officer are to observe the SAFE handling of firearms, enforce the rules of the particular range and sport, and assist shooters when necessary for the safe operation of the particular shooting event. The pre-requisite is obviously the knowledge of basic firearms safety, which is fairly universal. Additional training can be had at the various ranges unique to the particular sport or event. Applicants for RO duty should be prepared to volunteer time certain that you are willing to work and be reliable.

Please talk about Range Officer duties with your fellow members, step up and volunteer for your benefit and the continuing benefit of your fellow members. There are some "perks" for those who volunteer to be a Range Officer. The shooting sports cannot exist without the dedicated enthusiastic support of the participants.

Charter Life Membership

At the last board meeting, it was discussed and approved a **Charter Life Membership**. If you would like to purchase a Charter life membership, applications are available in the Clubhouse bar. This is a limited offering for the first 200 applicants. You must be a member for at least 4 years, and the fees for the charter life membership are pro-rated based on age. The fees could be as little as \$500 for a member 65 or older or as much as \$2000 for a 22 year old (who has been a member for at least 4 years). The membership card will be issued with CLM001 – CLM200 which replaces your current member number.

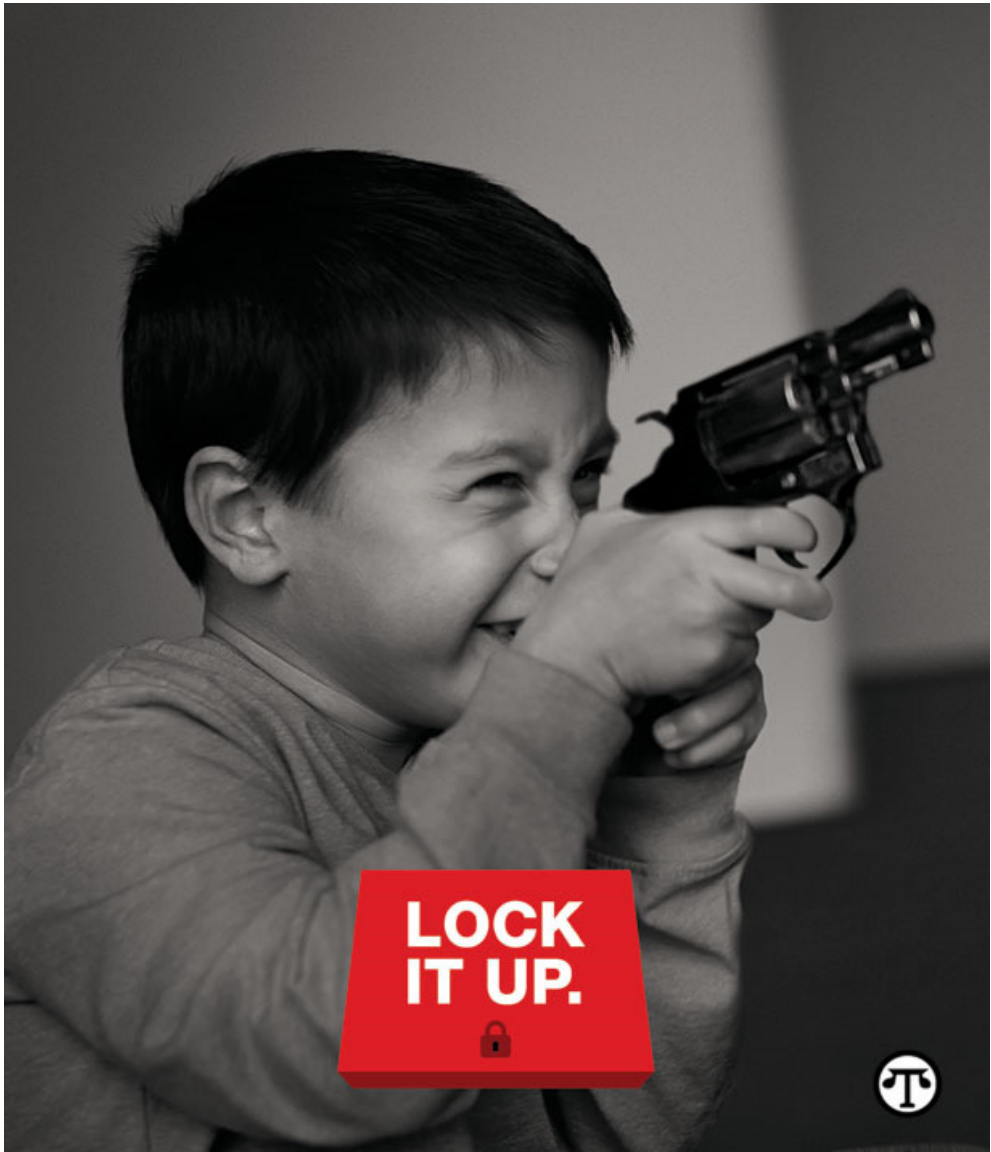
We can accommodate a maximum of 50 students per class so register early in the month to secure your place in the class.
