PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Greetings:

I must share some good news and some bad news with you. The good news is the Club is flourishing, and all of the ranges are enjoying capacity crowds and record revenues. Improvements to the Clubhouse and grounds have put a new face on the Club that was long overdue, thanks in great part to Alyce Herrera. These improvements did not come cheap and future improvements will also be costly, however they are a good investment in the long run.

We currently have approximately 2,000 members, which amounts to an annual income of \$100,000.00 per year. We have to upgrade the electrical system to the north side of the Club and Skeet & Trap fields, which may cost \$150,000.00 or more. Obviously, there goes a year's income plus. The Club, not unlike you, must prioritize our expenditures and stay within our budgets. In addition to the electrical matter, we also have some Americans with Disabilities Act matters that will need some attention, which maybe rather costly as well. Mr. Fred Smith has volunteered to head a yet to be formed committee to address these matters, more on this as the process develops. The concerns of the Federal, State, and local EPA have been addressed and a relationship established to work cooperatively to address any issues in the future.

I mention all of this to alert you that we may face economic hard times in the not too distant future requiring us all to pitch in to maintain our economic solvency and have enough reserve to prepare for any future unanticipated emergencies or matters, continue improvements, maintenance, and keep up with inflation. None of the things I just mentioned are life threatening to the Club right now, but we must be prepared for any foreseeable eventuality.

Now for some very sad news, long time member and range officer, Mary Snider experienced her mother passing away last month and her husband passed away suddenly this month. Our thoughts and prayers go out to her during this difficult time. May they rest in peace.

If your name is on the list above, you need not call and ask me when your membership card is coming, it will be put into the mail around the middle of the month in which this notice has been sent (If January, around Jan 20th, if March, around March 20th, and so on).

About Dues Final Notice Letters:

Right about August 1st, many people received a serious sounding letter about a "Final Dues Notice". I have been getting reports that many members never received an initial Dues notice. By the time I ran the report on July 21st, I found that there were 788 members who had not yet paid their dues (in the past 3 years, this number had only been about 250).

When I discussed this with other board members, one of them mentioned how a postal employee had "thrown out" a bunch of mail they didn't want to process. When I submitted the dues notices in Late April to the Mailing service for a May 1st mailing over 1900 dues notices went out, both prospects and regular members. Fully 1/3 did not make it to the right place. Per the Club Bylaws (Article VI, Section 3), I have to send out a Final Dues Notice before Aug 1st regardless if a member had gotten the initial dues notice or not, and that is what I sent. According to the Bylaws, Sept 15th is the last day I can receive dues without assessing a late penalty. Some complained that they did not get the notice until after Aug 1st, and that is okay since you still had approximately 40 days to make payment with no penalty.

I mailed notices out on July 28th and July 29th. I have since processed (as of Aug 14th, the day I wrote this report) 430 payments. Thank you for your prompt payment after actually receiving a notice, either the initial one or the "final" one sent last month.


