RRGC RIFLE & PISTOL RANGE SAFETY RULES REMINDERS

- ◆ Eye & Ear protection are Mandatory.
- ◆ Uncase and Case all Firearms at the shooting table – muzzles pointed down range.
- ◆ Upon **CEASE FIRE**, unload, clear, and open all firearms – **properly insert chamber safety flag** – stay behind yellow safety line.
- ◆ During Cease Fire, do not approach the shooting table for any reason! Ask a RSO for help.
- ◆ **SLOW FIRE** – 4 seconds between shots.
- ◆ Added target - Center must be on or inside the 7 ring.
- ◆ Finger off trigger until your sights are aligned on your target and you have made a conscious decision to shoot.
- ◆ Muzzle “sweeps” are strictly prohibited.
- ◆ Uncased firearms are carried only by a RSO, unloaded, muzzle up, with chamber safety flag inserted in the empty chamber, and the action open.
- ◆ Return used targets and *retrieve ID, before departing.*
- ◆ Do not intentionally shoot target frames.

**Please Ask a Range Safety Officer for Assistance.
Properly Dispose Your Brass & Trash Before Leaving.
Practice Safety at all times. Enjoy your range time!**



25 YARD LINE RULES REMINDERS

- ◆ Only pistol caliber guns, shotguns (with a stock), and black powder pistols, rifles, and shotguns are permitted.
- ◆ Slide target in from the top in-between pipes.
- ◆ Only guns with sighting devices may be used.
- ◆ Must properly use sights on the firearm.
- ◆ **SLOW FIRE** – 4 seconds between shots.
- ◆ Shotguns require a “Shotgun Target” hung only at a shotgun lane.

◆ Standing or stool seated shooting positions only.

100 YARD LINE RULES REMINDERS

- ◆ Do not walk between shooting tables – Go to either end of the range and briskly walk down range.
- ◆ When firing, muzzles must extend at least 2 inches beyond the forward edge of the shooting table.
- ◆ Use brass ejection screens when necessary.
- ◆ Slide target into frame - **Do Not Bend Cardboard.**
- ◆ All frames moved to 50 yards must be returned to 100 yards when finished.
- ◆ All rifles must be bore-sighted by a RSO, first!
- ◆ NOTICE: Rule violations may result in ejection from Range without fee refund.

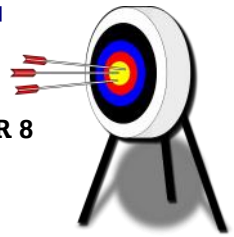

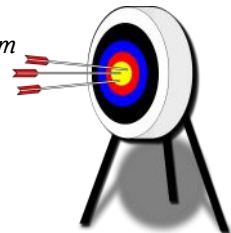
