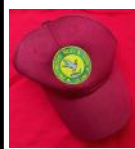

RSATA is a competition held on the Shotgun Range the second Saturday of each month. Entry per event is \$20 Skeet/\$20 Trap. (Shells not included).

Entry includes 2 rounds (50 clays) per discipline, you may enter Skeet, or Trap, or both.

There are 2 series per year, each is 6 events (Jan-June & July-Dec) with your best 4 scores counted for awards presented twice a year.

Awards typically are belt buckles for winners of skeet classes A, B, and C and Trap A and B, with prizes for 2nd and 3rd places depending on the number of class participants.

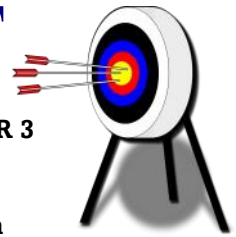

Hi Friends at the Richmond Rod & Gun Club,

I was recently accepted as a member of the Presidio Chapter of the DAR (Daughters of the American Revolution). I became interested in the **Wreaths Across America Program** which places wreaths on veteran's graves in December. They are not "Christmas" wreaths. They are to honor the service of our veterans and have meaning as such.

Wreaths Across America began in 1992 with a donation of 5,000 wreaths to Arlington National Cemetery. Thousands of volunteers worked to get them delivered and placed. By 2023, it had grown to 4,225 cemeteries participating across the country. Over 3 million Veteran's Wreaths were placed in total across the country in 2023.

At Arlington alone, 68 tractor-trailers delivered over 259,000 wreaths which were placed by more than 35,000 volunteers. 717 loads of wreaths were delivered across the country by hundreds of volunteer professional truck drivers driving donated equipment and fuel from approximately 332 transportation partners. More than 3 million volunteers across the country helped place the wreath. In 2018, 9,387 wreaths were laid in the American Cemetery in Normandy, France.

My DAR Chapter is partnering with NSDAR (a national sponsor) to get as many wreaths as possible placed in the **San Francisco National Cemetery in the Presidio** again this year. **As Chair of this worthwhile cause, I am asking my friends in the Richmond Rod & Gun Club to sponsor a wreath.
