Wreaths Across America began in 1992 with a donation of 5,000 wreaths to Arlington National Cemetery. Thousands of volunteers worked to get them delivered and placed. By 2023, it had grown to 4,225 cemeteries participating across the country. Over 3 million Veteran's Wreaths were placed in total across the country in 2023.

At Arlington alone, 68 tractor-trailers delivered over 259,000 wreaths which were placed by more than 35,000 volunteers. 717 loads of wreaths were delivered across the country by hundreds of volunteer professional truck drivers driving donated equipment and fuel from approximately 332 transportation partners. More than 3 million volunteers across the country helped place the wreath. In 2018, 9,387 wreaths were laid in the American Cemetery in Normandy, France.

My DAR Chapter is partnering with NSDAR (a national sponsor) to get as many wreaths as possible placed in the San Francisco National Cemetery in the Presidio again this year. As Chair of this worthwhile cause, I am asking my friends in the Richmond Rod & Gun Club to sponsor a wreath. The cost is \$17 and they can be ordered on line at the link below:
