## **RRGC PISTOL & RIFLE RANGE** **RULES AND SAFETY REMINDERS**

### **25 Yard Line Rules Reminders**

- ◆ Only pistol calibers, shotguns (with rear stock) and black powder are permitted.
- ◆ Slide target in from the top in between the “pipes”.
- ◆ Must properly use sights on the firearm.
- ◆ **SLOW FIRE** – 4 seconds between shots.
- ◆ Shotguns require a “Shotgun Target” – hung only on the designated “shotgun” lane.

### **100 Yard Line Rules Reminders**

- ◆ Do not walk between benches – Go to the ends and briskly walk down range.
- ◆ When firing, muzzles must be beyond the end of the bench.
- ◆ Use ejection screens when necessary.
- ◆ Slide Target into slide of frame. **Do Not Bend.**
- ◆ All frames may be moved to 50 yards – return to 100 yds when finished.
- ◆ All rifles **MUST** be bore sighted by an RRGCRSO!  
*NOTICE: Rule violations may result in ejection from the Range without a fee refund.*

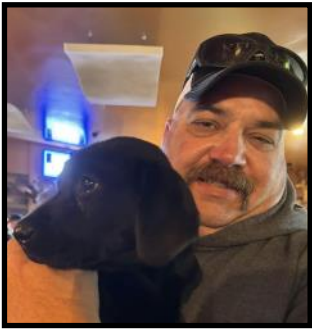

There are 2 series per year, each is 6 events (*Jan-June & July-Dec*) with your best 4 scores counted for awards presented twice a year.

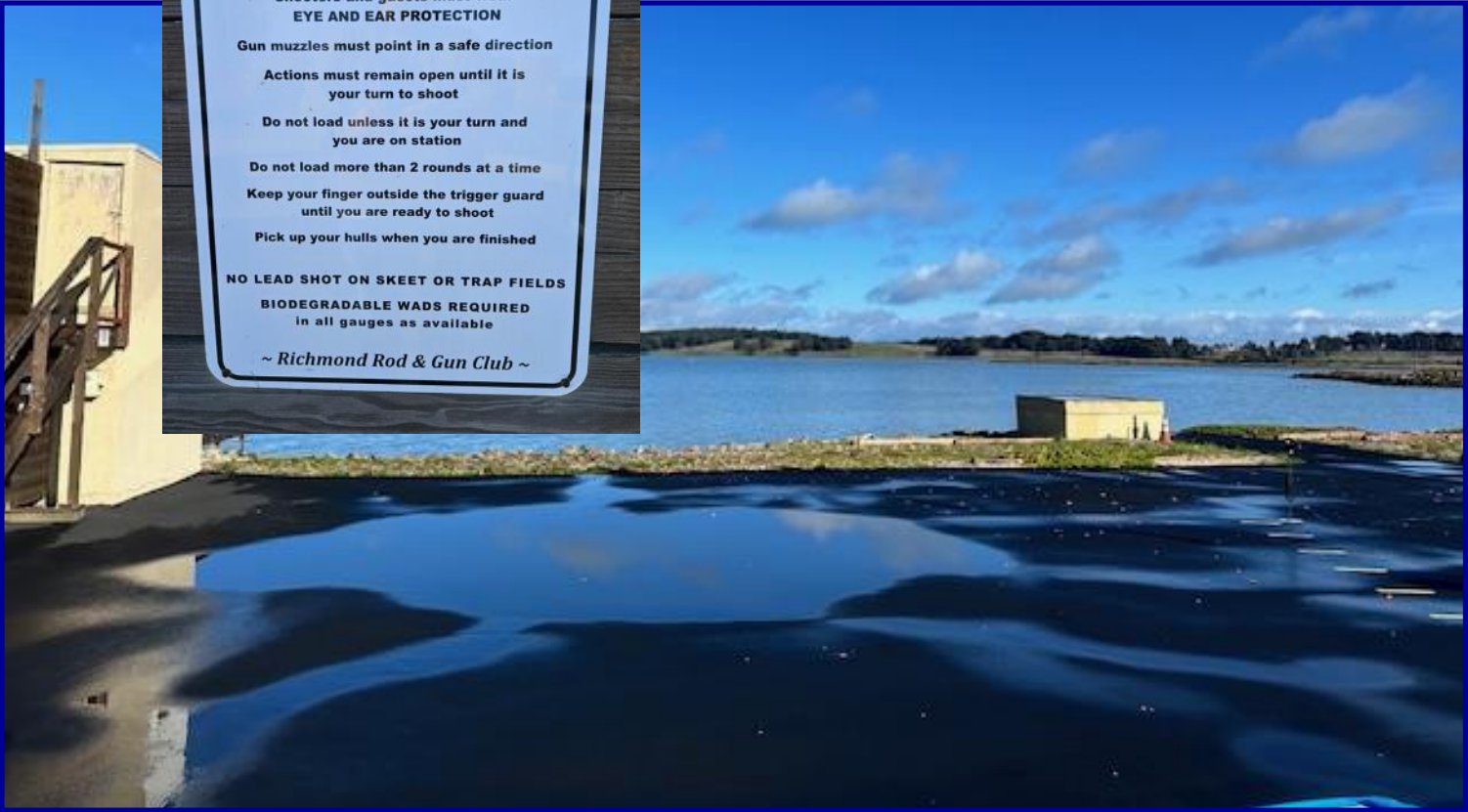
Awards typically are belt buckles for winners of skeet classes A, B, and C and Trap A and B, with prizes for 2nd and 3rd places depending on the number of class participants.

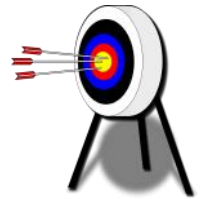

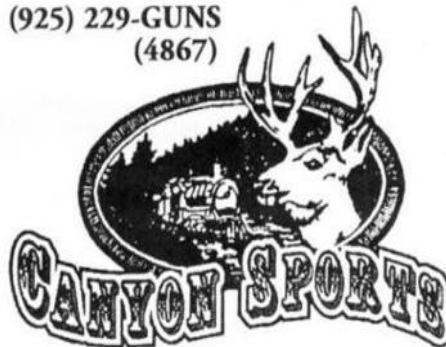
