RRGC RIFLE & PISTOL RANGE—RULES AND SAFETY REMINDERS

- Eye & Ear protection is mandatory.
- Uncase & Recase Firearms on the front shooting bench – muzzles down range.
- Uncased firearms not permitted in or on any of the rear bench areas.
- At CEASE FIRE, unload, clear and open firearms insert chamber flag – stay behind yellow safety line.
- Do not approach the bench for any reason during cease fire!
- ♦ SLOW FIRE 4 seconds between shots.
- ♦ Shooter applied target must be inside the 7 ring on the target board. (11" max.)
- Finger off trigger until on target and ready.
- ♦ Muzzle "sweeps" are strictly prohibited.
- Uncased firearms are carried unloaded, muzzle up with chamber flag and the action open.
- Return used targets & retrieve ID.
- ♦ Do not intentionally shoot target frames.

Ask a Range Officer for assistance when necessary.

Practice Safety at All Times!

25 Yard Line Rules Reminders

- Only pistol calibers, shotguns (with rear stock) and black powder are permitted.
- Slide target in from the top in between the "pipes".
- ♦ Must properly use sights on the firearm.
- ♦ <u>SLOW FIRE</u> 4 seconds between shots.
- Shotguns require a "Shotgun Target" hung only on the metal frame at the far end.

100 Yard Line Rules Reminders

- Do not walk between benches G the ends and briskly walk down range.
- When firing, muzzles must be beyond the end of the bench.
- Use ejection screens when necessary.
 Slide Target into slide of frame. <u>Do Not Bend</u>.
- All frames may be moved to 50 yards return to 100 yds when finished.
- All rifles MUST be bore sighted by an RRGC RSO!
 NOTICE: Rule violations may result in ejection from

the Range without a fee refund.


